- Walk away—bullies need an audience.
- Tell an adult.
- Speak out against the bullying.

Things to consider:

- Can I view others' differences as positive?
- Could I get to know someone before I decide how I feel about him or her?
- What kind of world do I want to help create by the way I treat others?
- Is there an adult I could tell who will help?
- Could I occasionally invite someone being bullied to have lunch with me?
- Could I refuse to make fun of others?
- How would I feel about refusing to partake in the taunting of others?
- Am I willing to question my friendships with people who bully?
- Would I risk or question my own social standing to help someone who is being bullied?
- Can I be open to viewing other's differences as positive?
- Is bullying someone fair or right?
