Legal advocacy for **1,790** victims.

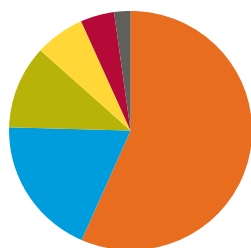
Therapy with **319** children, teens, and adults.

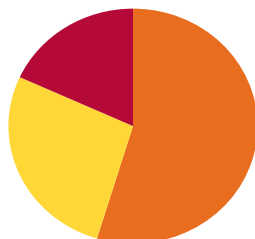

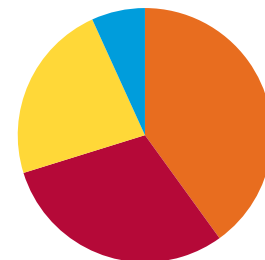

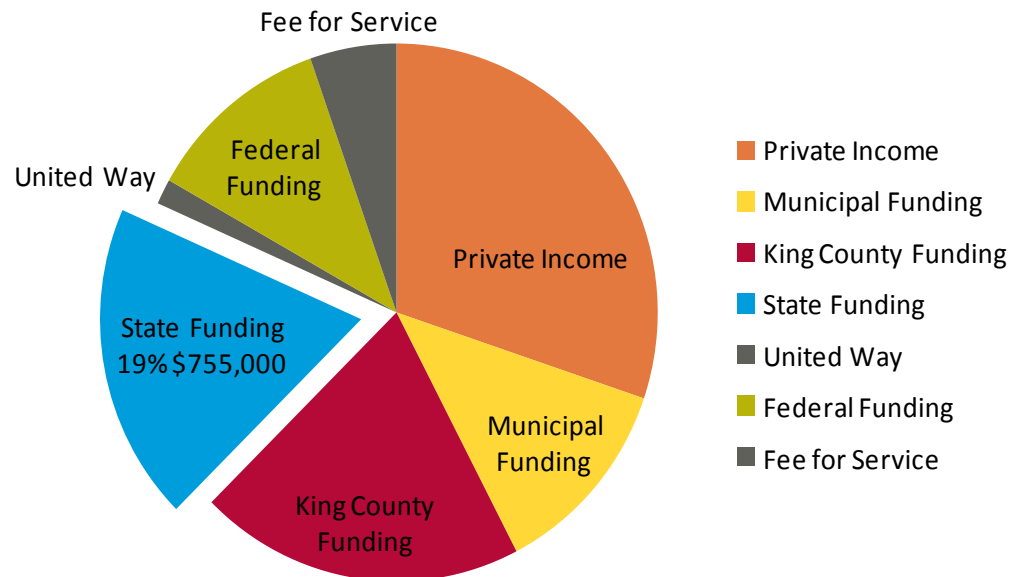
