Legal advocacy for **1,460** victims; **\$540** per client.

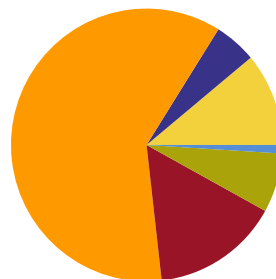
Therapy with **262** children, teens and adults; **\$2,147** per client.

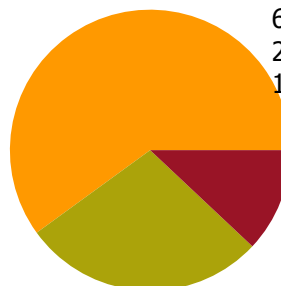
