Legal advocacy for **1,403** victims.

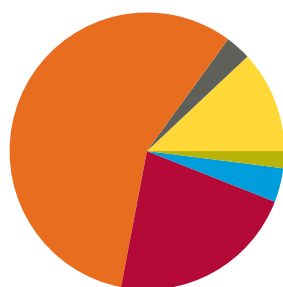
Therapy with **382** children, teens and adults.

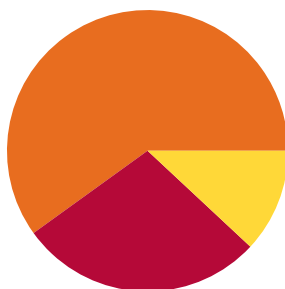
